The staff complement is  $\pm$  910 (1 140 approved posts). The annual recurrent budget of the

The Under Secretary is charged with the responsibility to direct investigations and assess the potential of surface and underground water resources; to facilitate the strategic planning of water supply development within the national and regionally shared river basin context; to ensure sustainable water utilization by executing water related applied research into water technology, ecology and environmental matters and to manage pollution control. Administrative responsibilities relate to personnel, finance, policy and development of procedures, development, organization, planning, programming, directing and controlling.
